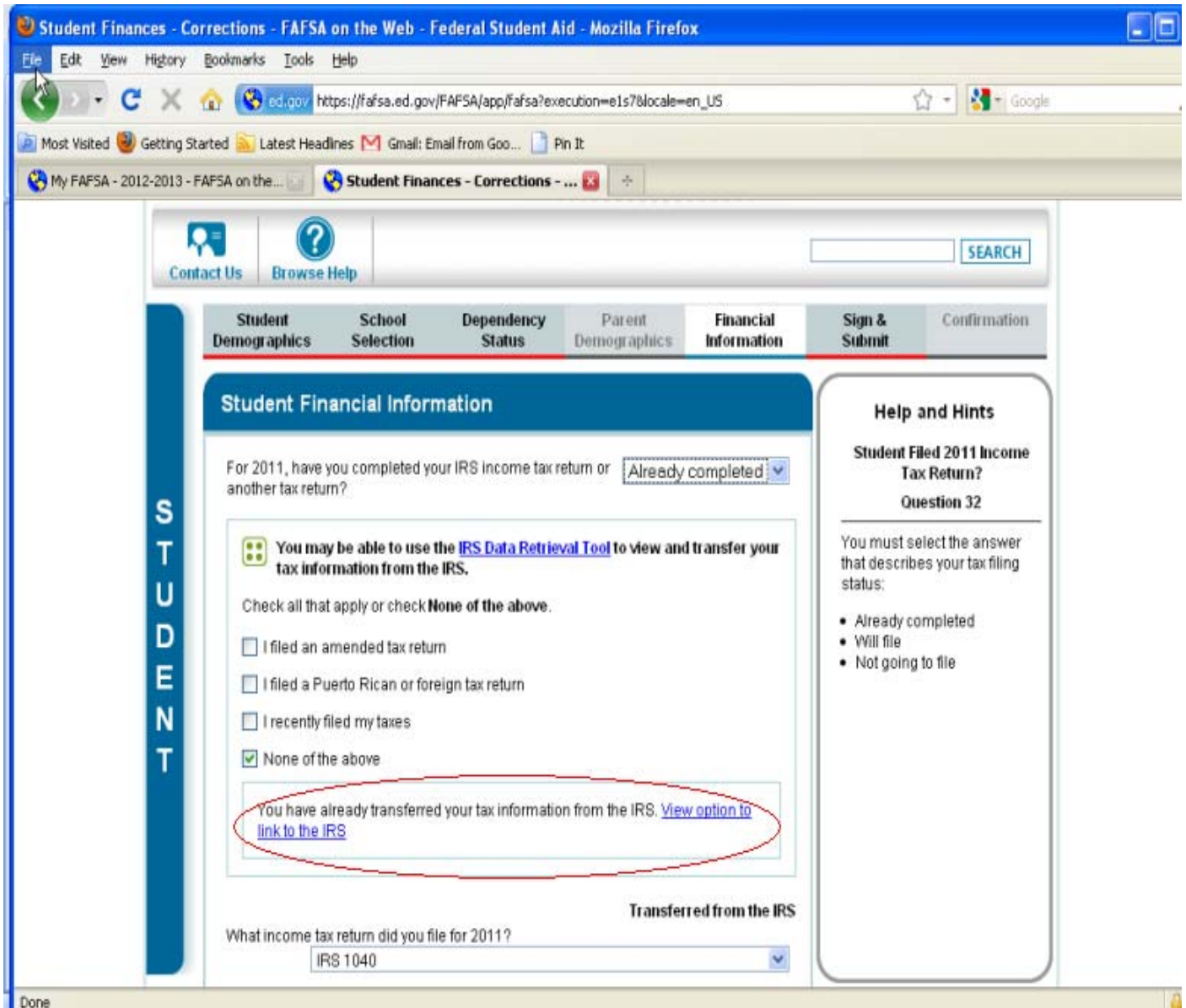


# How to Link A Tax Return To A Previously Submitted FAFSA

1. Go to [www.FAFSA.gov](http://www.FAFSA.gov)
2. Enter your log in information
3. Click the 'Make A Correction' link


