

**NOTICE TO ALL FEDERAL AND STATE
GRANT RECIPIENTS
REMEDIAL CLASS LIMITS**

Federal and State regulations allow a total of 30 hours of remedial course work (ENG 070, ENG 080, ENG 090, ENG 110 and DRE 096, DRE 097, DRE 098, ENG 002, ENG 011 and DMA 010, DMA 020, DMA 030, DMA 040, DMA 050, DMA 060, DMA 070, DMA 080, DMA 090 and MAT 060, MAT 070, MAT 080, DMS 001, DMS 003, MAT 003, MAT 010, MAT 021, MAT 043, MAT 052, MAT 071) taken beyond a student's 30 hour limit cannot be included in enrollment totals to calculate the financial aid payment.

This means after you have taken a total of 30 hours of remedial coursework your future financial aid payments may be reduced to reflect payments only for the hours of regular college coursework for which you are taking each semester.

If you are unsure of the number of remedial hours you have attempted please log onto Self Service, review your college transcript and count the credit hours for each of the remedial hour courses for which you have previously enrolled. You may also speak with your advisor concerning your need for remedial coursework and the number of hours of remedial work you have attempted in the past.
